Adding lever handles to the Losmandy G11 knurled clutch knobs

Tools and Parts:

- 1. 2 inch long, 3/-8-16 one-end threaded stainless steel 18-8 studs (make the handles) (McMaster-Carr \$5.63 each 97042A324 (97042A324)
- 2. 5/16 drill (use for 3/8-16 tap).
- 3. 3/8-16 tap
- 4. tapping lubricant

Steps:

- 1. Drill a hole straight through the diameter of the RA and DEC clutch knobs, using the 5/16 drill. Use plenty of tapping lubricant also for drilling, to keep the aluminum from galling on the drill bit.
- 2. Tap the hole using the 3/16-18 tap. Start from each outside and tap toward the middle. Do not tap the hole all the way through you want the threads to be incomplete, so the threaded rod (handles) will lodge in the hole.
